





Sponsors disclosed that entries in the competition, open until May 12, have been received from all boroughs of the city and are still pouring in.

A dramatic presentation based on a recent novel of Negro struggle in the South is being prepared by a group of Brooklyn teen-agers.

A musical skit on the history of the Negro people has been entered by teen-agers in Corona.

Far Rockaway teen-agers are introducing a musical narrative on civil rights and a 40 person chorus from the Allerton section of the Bronx has been entered in the competition.

Individual entries of paintings, ceramics, model trains, monologues, solo musical selections, essays, poetry and drawings have been received from all boroughs.

First prize in the competition is \$100 towards a scholarship for cultural study in a school of the winner's choice. Various other prizes are being offered.
